Some of our favorite winter activities include ice-skating on the frozen lake or at the 1980 Olympic Oval, cross-country skiing or snowshoeing pristine trails, or downhill skiing on the longest vertical drop in the East coast at Whiteface Mountain.

Warmer weather brings endless adventures. Take a tour of Lake Placid aboard our 35' mahogany Hacker-Craft. Perhaps go swimming or fishing, kayaking or canoeing, or captain one of our electric boats - Lake Placid is one of the cleanest spring-fed lakes in New York. Shady forests beckon, clear streams tumble along, trails meander toward the sky. The Adirondack Park has 46 mountains over 4,000 feet high, 3,000 lakes and ponds and 30,000 miles of river and stream to explore. And napping in the lean-to is a long-standing Adirondack tradition.

Whether taking in pristine Lake Placid by canoe or kayak, snowshoeing on peaceful trails, or enjoying a wine tasting with our Sommelier, stress is dismissed.

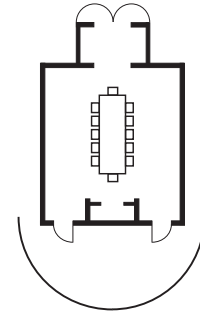

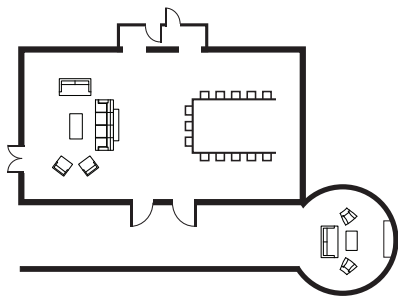
..... Baby Bootlegger Room



Our Baby Bootlegger Room is the perfect place to gather for a meeting or private dinner. This beautiful room is anchored by a stone fireplace at the back wall and a huge outdoor fireplace just outside on the veranda. Tall windows offer lake and mountain views. The room holds a vintage painting of the famous boat, and the graceful wood frame of a rowboat overhead serves as a chandelier.

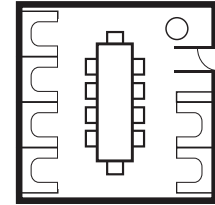
Adirondack Room



Big French doors extend the Adirondack Room's space outdoors to the massive stone terrace, where Lake Placid and Whiteface Mountain serve as a backdrop, and two large wood-burning fireplaces blaze. The Adirondack Room is both grand and airy, a composition of gorgeous stonework, tree trunk columns and custom-made carpets that mimic the forest floor. State-of-the-art audio/visual equipment is the rule here, including a high definition screen, surround sound with microphone, and high-speed internet access.

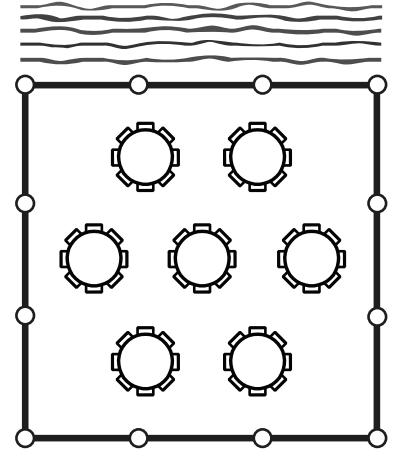
The Wine Cellar

PLANES

- Lake Placid Airport (LKP): 10 Minutes - Public use airport that can handle small planes.
- Adirondack Regional Airport (SLK): 25 Minutes - This Airport is capable of handling aircraft as large as a Boeing 757. It has a category 1 instrument runway that is 6,573 foot long, allowing aircraft to land safely even in poor weather. Cape Air provides daily commercial service to and from Logan International Airport in Boston, MA. To ensure passengers find a flight that meets their schedule, Cape Air operates 3 to 5 round trip flights a day year round.
- Plattsburgh International Airport (PBG): 45 Minutes
- Burlington International Airport (YUL): 2 Hours
- Albany International Airport (ALB): 2.5 Hours

AUTOMOBILES

From New York City

- Head northeast on FDR Drive.
- Exit right onto the Willis Avenue Bridge
- Make immediate left onto I-87 N/Deegan Expressway and cross the Tappan Zee Bridge. Continue on I-87 until exit 30.
- Take exit 30 and bear left following signs for 9N and Rt. 73. Continue on Rt. 73 until you reach the intersection at the first traffic light.
- Take a left onto Rt. 86 onto Rt. 86 will lead you through the heart of town; the road will bear left at the end of Main Street. Follow this is 1.5 miles and there will be a sign for Whiteface Inn Lane on the right.
- Drive another 1.0 miles until you see a sign on your right for Lake Placid Lodge.
- Turn right and proceed approximately .5 miles you will see our reception sign on the right.
- Turn right into the driveway.
