Nestled between Sonoma County's gorgeous Dry Creek and Alexander Valleys with sweeping views of the Mayacamas Mountains. A wisteria covered pergola, spacious lawns, luscious landscaping and vineyard views make for the perfect wine country backdrop for you and your guests.

Quiet yet connected, the Geyserville Inn is easily accessible to Highway 101, located six miles north of the iconic small town of Healdsburg and 70 miles north of San Francisco.

Locally owned and operated by two generations of Christensen family members and within minutes of some of Sonoma County's most celebrated wineries, the Geyserville Inn is a destination wedding venue that will provide you and your guests with an unforgettable experience.

On-site lodging at the Inn allows everyone to enjoy luxury accommodations during your special occasion. The Inn provides 38 luxury guestrooms and 3 king suites with views of the pool or neighboring vineyards. Majority of guestrooms feature balconies and/or fireplaces with beautiful furnishings, complimentary wireless internet access and daily housekeeping.

Just steps away from the Inn is the Geyserville Grille formerly known as the historic Hoffman House. This beautiful place to eat features authentic California Wine Country Cuisine paired with an extensive amount local vintages. Enjoy dining under the redwoods on the patio, our newly redesigned Jasmine Deck or inside overlooking the vineyards.

Wedding Venue

Our beautiful outdoor venue is available April – November for your celebration. We can accommodate up to 200 guests and only host one wedding on-site per weekend. This means you have our full attention and easy access to our property for setup the evening before and breakdown the morning after your wedding.

The main event area, Doyle Clifton Park, is a 9,000 sq. ft. manicured lawn framed by trees, rose bushes and lavender, white arbors hugged by wisteria, and surrounded by vineyards and mountain vistas.

Say “I do!” under our wisteria-covered pergola surrounded by lush landscaping and estate vines. Toast with your guests on the Packard Lawn for an intimate cocktail hour, then dine and dance the night away under the stars.

Utilize the Packard Room event center for storage starting the day before your wedding, getting ready in the morning with your wedding party, and during your celebration for private restroom access for guests.

Accommodations

One of the incredible advantages to hosting your wedding at the Geyserville Inn that many other venues can't offer is that you and your guests have the convenience of staying right on-site in one of our **41 standard & deluxe guestrooms and suites**. Group rates and room blocks are available. The main building offers 38 recently renovated guestrooms, primarily single Queen and King rooms, with 5 Double Queen rooms for guests requiring rooms with 2 beds.

All guestrooms are non-smoking and include a coffee maker, mini-fridge, complimentary wireless internet, air conditioning, windows that open, and 50-inch flat screen smart televisions. Many also include patios, balconies, and cozy fireplaces.

Geyserville Inn offers a block of 5 rooms for you and whomever you choose without a deposit fee required. Speak with the Director of Sales today to discuss guestroom blocks of more than 5 at discounted rates for you, your wedding party, family and friends.

King Suites

In a private building adjacent to the wedding venue are our 3 luxurious King Suites. Upstairs, the **Tuscan King Suite** and **Key West King Suite** feature king bedrooms, living room with cozy fireplace, Jacuzzi tub, and large private balconies with breathtaking views of the Alexander Valley. The **Zinfandel Kitchen King Suite** on the main level includes a small kitchen and dining area.

Our suites enable you and your wedding party to have a relaxed weekend when you can easily and comfortably get ready right on site. At the end of the night, a suite is the perfect romantic retreat for the newlyweds.

All 3 King Suites are required to be reserved by you or your guests on the night of the wedding. 1 King Suite of your choosing included in the site fee.

Guest House

We also offer a wine country themed two-bedroom guest house located just down the street from the inn. The off-site **Guest House** features two bedrooms with queen beds, a large kitchen with dining table, hardwood floors, and living room with pull-out sofa bed. Sleeps 4-6 guests.

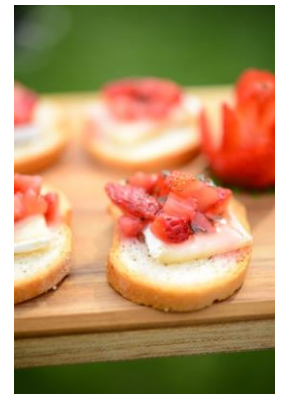

Frequently Asked Questions

Can I decorate the venue?

Absolutely! You are welcome to add your own special touches to enhance the natural beauty of our venue. We just need to know in advance what you are planning to provide. All setup and removal of decorations is the responsibility of the wedding party and/or your vendors.

Can we bring in our own caterer?

The Geyserville Grille is the exclusive caterer of our on-site events and will provide you with a full-service catering staff. Our Executive Chef and culinary team have designed an extensive selection of catering menus to choose from and are happy to customize any dish to your exact specifications.

Do you offer menu tastings?

We are pleased to offer all of our contracted couples the opportunity to taste their menu prior to their event. Complimentary tastings are typically coordinated 3-4 months prior to event date to allow for seasonal availability of ingredients and possible menu updates.

Can I provide my own wine?

Our bar packages include your choice of a variety of wine selections from local producers in the Dry Creek and Alexander Valleys, but we know you might have your own personal favorites you would like to share with your guests. You are welcome to provide your own wine or champagne selections for \$12++ corkage fee per 750mL bottle. All other alcohol must be provided by the hotel.

Do you require a wedding coordinator?

We require that you hire a professional, outside wedding planner to assist with month-of coordination if your guest list is 100 or more, including your rehearsal, ceremony, and day-of needs to ensure a flawless event. Vendor list available. Our event team will provide planning assistance for portions of your event involving lodging, catering, and venue setup. The right wedding coordinator can take charge of numerous details, from large items like creating of your event timeline and management of all other vendors, to small things like setting up place cards and table décor. We find that many couples do not have the time or live close enough to Sonoma County to plan and execute the special touches or accents they envision for their wedding. This is where your "limited service" or "month of" wedding planner can help to ensure everything goes according to plan and you and your guests just get to enjoy the magical moments of your celebration.

Do I have to reserve a minimum number of guestrooms?

The only guestrooms you are required to reserve are the three King Suites located near the event venue (do you want other hotel guests who aren't part of your celebration to be hanging out right in the middle of your reception?). Unlike many other wedding venues that offer both event space and on-site guest accommodations, we do not require you or your guests to reserve a minimum number of guestrooms. Though, we are happy to help setup a personal room block to make it easy for your guests to book their own guestrooms on-site.

Is there a charge for cake cutting?

There is no cake cutting or service fee. We are delighted to cut and serve the cake for you as part of our complimentary services and are happy to share recommendations for local bakeries. Dessert selections must come from a licensed and insured bakery. Sorry, no homemade items permitted.

Frequently Asked Questions

I'm putting together welcome bags of goodies for my guests.

Can you distribute these?

We are pleased to distribute your welcome bags to guests at the front desk when they check in to the hotel at no charge. Additional fees may apply if bags are delivered to guestrooms or excessive size/quantity for distribution.

Can our event start earlier than 4pm?

Yes, for an earlier start time, pricing is \$1,200++ per hour of overtime.

What time does our event need to end?

Sonoma County Ordinance requires outdoor events to end at 10pm. Your vendors will still have plenty of time after 10pm to break down and remove any equipment or your personal belongings.

Can we have amplified music?

Yes, a band or DJ are welcome, and music can go until 10pm.

What is required to secure my wedding date?

A signed contract and non-refundable deposit of 25% of the estimated event total are required to confirm your event. Until the deposit and a signed contract are received, the reservation is unsecured and may be booked by another party with deposit and contract.

When is the remaining balance due?

Full estimated event balance due 30 days prior to your wedding date.

When is the guest count due?

Lots of decisions are finalized around your expected guest count (number of tables needed, linen rentals, ordering of menu ingredients, staffing needs, etc.) so we require your minimum guaranteed guest count to be provided 30 days prior to your wedding date. Your guest count may be increased after this date but cannot be decreased.

Do you provide a tent in case of rain or umbrellas for shade?

All of these items are rented at your cost, but we have great relationships with several local rental companies and are happy to assist in this coordination.

What is your cancellation policy?

Initial deposit is non-refundable. If cancellation occurs less than 90 days prior to the event, you will be responsible for 100% of the estimated total event charges.

What is "Event Insurance" and is it required?

Special Event Liability Coverage protects you if you're held liable for property damage or bodily injury. There are a variety of companies that can provide this (often including your current home/auto insurance provider), though we also recommend WedSafe.com or WedSure.com. You are required to provide general liability insurance coverage, including property damage of \$2 million.

When can we visit the venue?

Our outdoor event spaces may be viewed informally on your own at any time (as long as there aren't other celebrations taking place, of course, please inquire with the Director of Sales). If you would like a full property tour or a more in-depth meeting to discuss event details or to view guestrooms, then an appointment with the Director of Sales is recommended, so that she may give your plans the attention they deserve and ensure guestroom availability for viewing. Weekday site tours are preferred, but Saturday appointments are also available with advance notice.
