If you are interested in using a caterer that is not on our list, we may be able to accommodate this for an additional fee (\$900), subject to approval. All one-time caterers must provide proof of insurance, business license and additional documentation, and be confirmed 45 days prior to the event. Please call (801) 521-7969 for more information. For safety reasons, all food served at Memorial House must be provided by a licensed caterer. Wedding cakes may be arranged through the bakery of your choice.

Bartending

Alcohol is allowed at Memorial House but must be served by a licensed bartender. Bar service must be arranged through one of our preferred caterers (see above) or through one of our pre-approved bartending services (listed below) to ensure that bartenders are certified, licensed, and insured. All alcohol service and consumption must comply with Utah state liquor laws. Cash bars are not allowed, and all alcohol must stay within the Memorial House premises. Frequently Asked Questions

How many people can Memorial House accommodate?

For the comfort and safety of your guests, we ask that you do not exceed 300 people. We can accommodate up to 150 people in the main hall for a sit-down dinner, and depending on your desired set up, additional dining space may be available in the garden room, patio or the south lawn.

What about parking?

Parking for Memorial House guests is available on the street within Memory Grove Park, accommodating about 140 cars. As part of your rental fee, we include a staff person at the entrance gate during the peak times your guests are arriving to allow entrance into the park.

How do I secure a date?

Reservations require a signed contract and a non-refundable deposit of \$500 that will be applied to the total rental fee. The remaining balance is due 45 days prior to your event.

How can I decorate the building?

You are welcome to decorate as you wish; however, Memorial House is a historic building, so tacking, taping, nailing, and tying to any surfaces is not allowed. Candles are NOT permitted at Memorial House. Sparklers and other forms of fireworks are not allowed, per park rules. Items that are difficult to clean up such as confetti, rice, fake flower petals, streamers, and balloon releases are not permitted. Bubbles or noise makers can be a good alternative for the send off.

When do we finalize the details of my event?

We will set up an appointment to review all of the details of your event approximately 45 days prior, as well as a \$500 damage deposit, which is refundable after the event.
