SPACE OVERVIEW

Venice Arts is a beautiful, creative space on Beach Avenue, in Venice's Marina Arts District. With a 4,200 square-foot indoor space and a large outdoor area, this venue is perfect for a daytime or nighttime indoor/outdoor event. The gallery features polished concrete floors and a rollup door opening onto a gated garden adorned with cafe lights and colorful plants. Light and airy with skylights throughout, Venice Arts is a fantastic location for that will make your party, special event, exhibition, screening, workshop, or meeting fun and memorable.



FEES/RATES

For Special Events:

weddings, birthday parties, bat/bar mitzvahs, workshops, seminars, meetings, screenings, etc.
(up to 200 people)

- \$3000 event fee (includes facility fee and cleaning) for weekend event (Friday, Saturday, or Sunday, 8 hours including set up and clean up). Additional charges for events that go past 11pm may apply.
- \$2000 for a weekday event.
- Additional time available for \$300/hour.



FEES/RATES

For Small Group Meetings:

smaller-sized meetings, workshops, get-togethers, etc. (up to 25 people)

- \$1500 day (up to 8 hours including set up and clean up)
- \$800 half day (up to 4 hours)
- \$200/hour (two hour minimum)



FEES/RATES

For Exhibition Rental:

- Entire Gallery: \$6,000 for 2–4 weeks or \$4000 for 1 week or shorter.
- Gallery Exhibition Rentals include a 3-hour Saturday night (or other, as agreed) opening reception (hosted by renting party).
- Artists may handle their own sales and keep 100% of sales proceeds, or may have Venice Arts handle sales for a 20% fee.
- Installation services available for an additional fee of \$50/hour.



BOOKING & INSURANCE

- A 50% deposit is required to reserve the date of your event.
- A \$500 fully refundable facility damage fee is required.
- Insurance is required. It is the responsibility of the organization/party to secure this insurance at your own expense. Please have your insurance agency list Venice Arts as the additionally insured for a minimum liability of \$1,000,000. Please email, send, or fax a copy of the insurance certificate to Venice Arts at least one week before your event.



WHAT'S INCLUDED?

Equipment:

- 26 Black Folding Chairs; 2 arm chairs
- Assorted tables: (3) 8'x2.5' tables, (4) 6'x1' tables, (2) 5'x2' long tables, (2) 4.5'x4.5' tables, (5) 4'x2.5' tables, (20) 4'x2' tables, (2) 4x2' half-round tables
- Stage (6x8', 18" high) (installation fee applies)
- Photobooth and video equipment (available for additional fee)

What's the capacity?

- Reception Style: 200 indoor | 300 indoor/outdoor
- Theater Style: 150
- Seated Banquet Style: 150
- Trade Show Exhibit: 10 8x10' booths or 8 10x10' booths

Where do we park?

Free street parking is available on Beach Avenue and the surrounding streets. For large parties with a planned valet, we can also recommend local parking lots.

How is the accessibility of the venue?

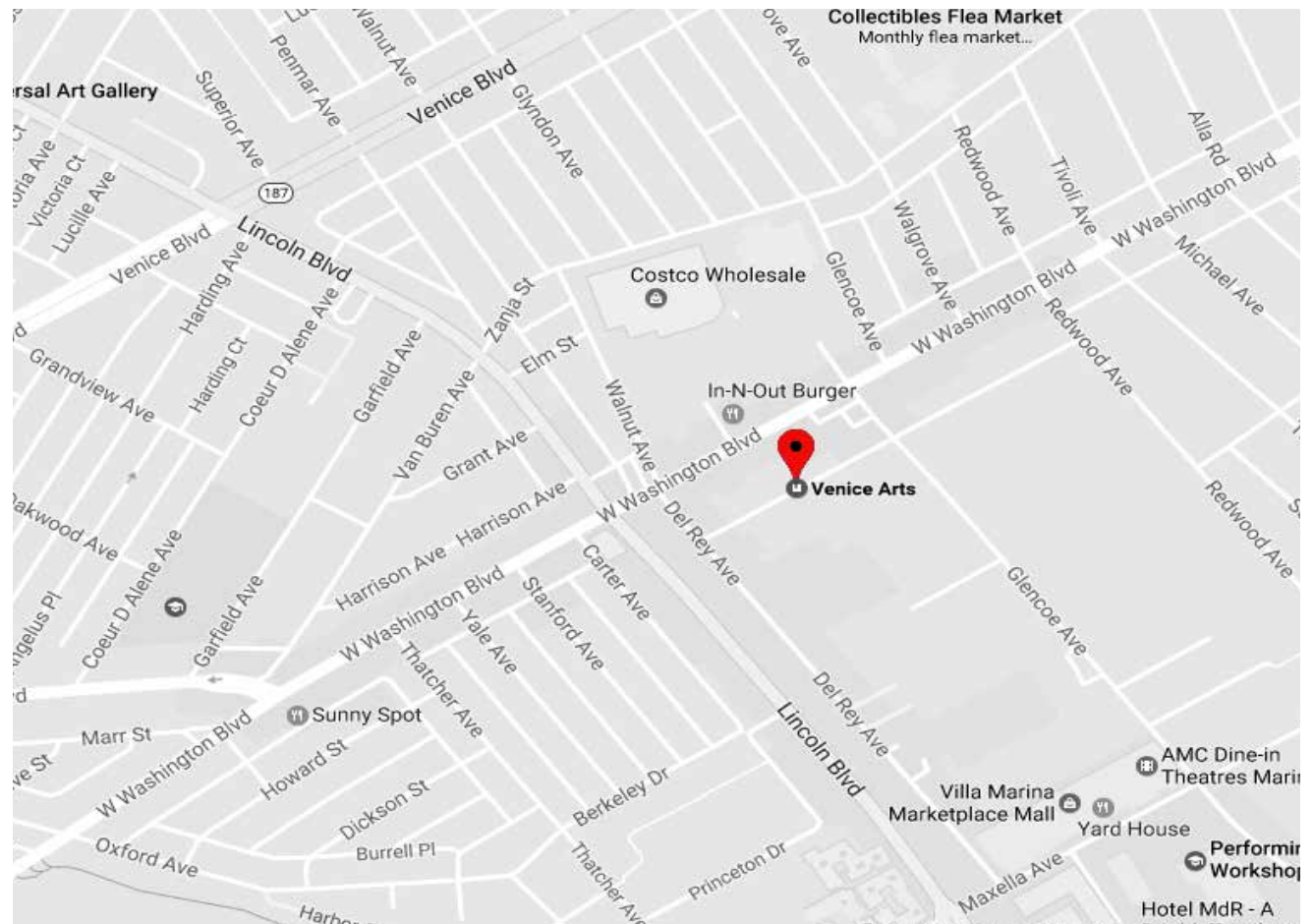
Venice Arts is located in a ground-floor storefront building. There is a reserved accessible parking spot and two A.D.A. compliant restrooms.

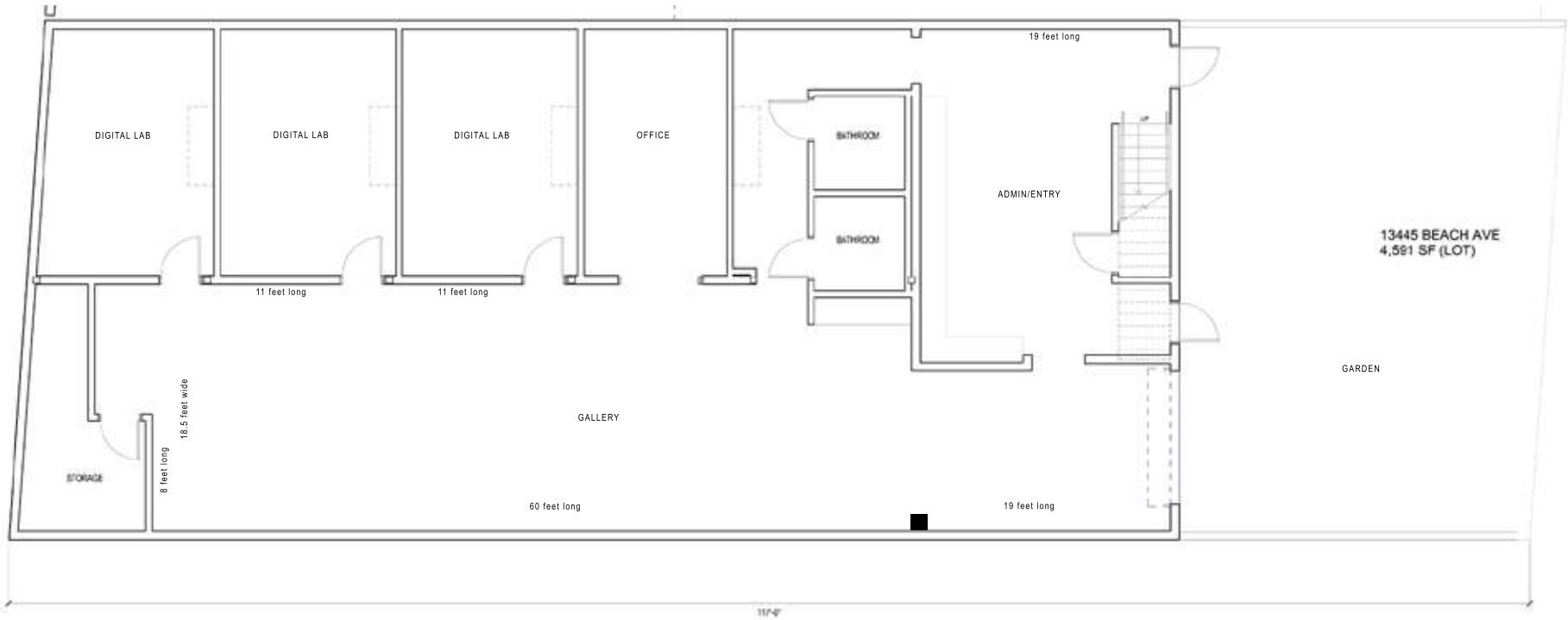
Who set-up/cleans-up for the event?

The renter is responsible for set up and basic breakdown and clean up for the event (stacking rental furniture and/or returning gallery furniture to original location, removing trash and displays, etc.).
