Open Bar Options

Priced per person for all guests ages 21 and over. Children are included at no additional cost.

House package

\$37 per person for 6 hours - *additional 1/2 hour available at \$3 per person
Includes wines, bottled beer, seltzers, well cocktails, soda and coffee service

Premium package

\$42 per person for 6 hours - *additional 1/2 hour available at \$4 per person
Includes wines, bottled beer, seltzers, call drinks, soda and coffee service

Beer & Wine package

\$29 per person for 6 hours - *additional 1/2 hour available at \$2 per person
Includes wines, bottled beer, seltzers, soda and coffee service

HORNBAKER GARDENS

We strongly advise you to include these directions with your invitations. These are the best routes for night time, inclement weather, or people unfamiliar with the roads.

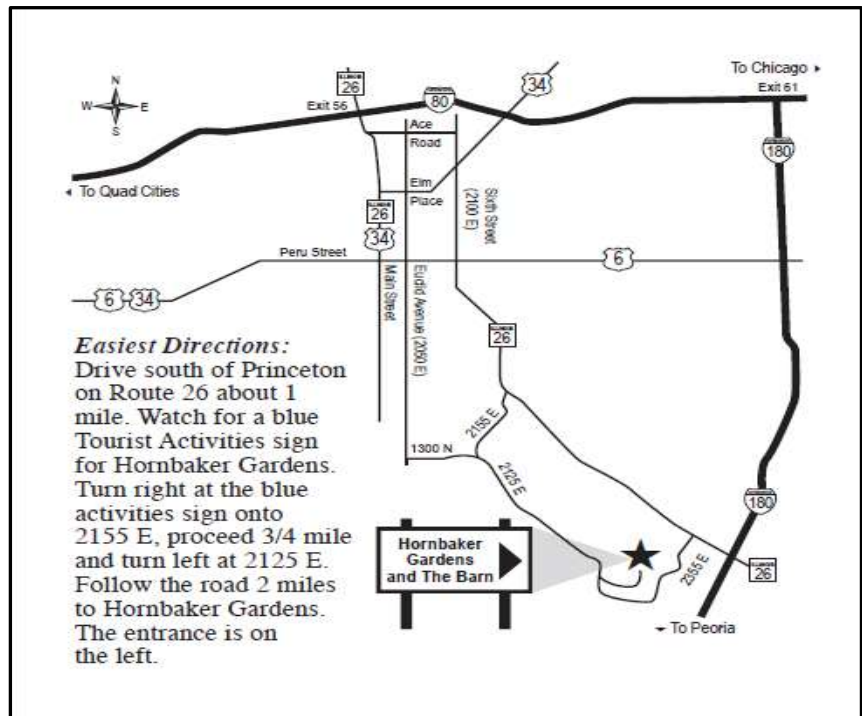
Directions from I-80 at Princeton, exit 56: Follow Rte 26 as it winds through Princeton, and continue south on Rte 26 from the east edge of town. About a mile or so south of town, watch for a blue "Tourist Activities" sign for Hornbaker Gardens. Turn right at the blue sign (2155 E St), and go about a half mile. Take the first left (at a Y intersection), and then go 2 miles until you see the Hornbaker Gardens sign on the left.

Directions from I-80 at exit 61: go south on I-180 about 1 mile, and exit at Rte 6. Go west about 3 miles to the stop sign on the east edge of Princeton. Turn left, or south, on Rt. 26 and go about 1 mile south of town. Watch for a blue "Tourist Activities" sign for Hornbaker Gardens. Turn right at the blue sign (2155 E St), and go about a half mile. Take the first left (at a Y intersection), and then go 2 miles until you see the Hornbaker Gardens sign on the left.

Directions from Peoria: Take Rte 29 North. It turns into I-180. Continue north to the Rte 26 Princeton exit. Turn left and go about 3 miles past the subdivisions and take a left on 2155 E St. Go about a half mile. Take the first left (at a Y intersection), and then go 2 miles

until you see the Hornbaker Gardens sign on the left. ****Important:** ignore the billboard sign for Hornbaker Gardens just after exiting I-180. This is a narrow, curvy country road not suitable for night time driving or inclement weather.

Directions from Bloomington: Take Rte 39 North. Take exit #51 for IL 71. Turn left (west) onto IL 71 toward Hennepin. IL 71 turns into I-180. Continue west and then north on I-180. Take the Rte 26 Princeton exit. ****Important:** do not exit until you see the large green exit sign that says Princeton. Ignore all the other exits for Rte 26. At the end of the ramp, turn left and go about 3 miles past the subdivisions and take a left on 2155 E St. Go about a half mile. Take the first left (at a Y intersection), and then go 2 miles until you see the Hornbaker Gardens sign on the left.



***Important:** ignore the billboard sign for Hornbaker Gardens just after exiting I-180. This is a narrow, curvy country road not suitable for night time driving or inclement weather.

HORNBAKER GARDENS

We know how much planning goes into preparing for your big day and how many details there are to consider. We have put together a list of some reminders of things that often get overlooked. We've also included some helpful tips we have learned that can go a long way in ensuring the events of your day run as smoothly as possible.

- **Rehearsal:** Rehearsal to be set, 8 weeks prior to wedding, based on The Barn's availability. At that time, we can also let you know if you will be able to get in The Barn the day prior to your wedding for decorating.
- **Linens:** Wherever you rent your linens, make sure they are scheduled to arrive when you are ready to begin decorating. Tables cannot be set with flowers, candles, water glasses and carafes, etc., nor can your napkins be folded and placed, until your tablecloths are in place, so make sure your linens are arriving earlier in the day.
- **Directions:** GPS is not the most reliable source for directions to our venue. We suggest you include the directions on the previous page with your invites.
- **Cake Cutting:** Make sure someone is assigned to cutting and serving your cake. If the person who made your cake is not responsible for this, please ask us for options. We have learned there is a bit of an art to cake cutting. **Also, don't forget to plan for plates, forks, and napkins, if this is not something already taken care of by your cake person.**
- **Host Duties:** We suggest you consider having a host and hostess greet your guests at the door when they arrive and explain to them where to go. This is especially helpful if you would prefer your guests not gather in the reception hall before moving outside for your ceremony. We have a couple of signs pointing guests to the ceremony along the sidewalk around the building, but some people may need to drop off a gift or need to use the restrooms before the ceremony. A host and/or hostess could be very helpful to you and your guests.
- **Release Tables:** Designate someone to release tables to your dinner buffet. Some caterers handle this, but others do not, so make sure to check with your caterer. This is also something your host and hostess could handle.
- **Ceremony Music:** If you have musicians playing for your ceremony, we need to have them here an hour early to do a sound check. Music is an important element of many ceremonies, and we want to make sure our sound staff is prepared to meet the needs of your musicians.
- **Golf Cart:** Don't forget we do have an 8-seater golf cart available to you to transport guests who may otherwise have a hard time walking to their seats. If you plan to use the golf cart, make sure to designate an usher or other responsible adult to be the driver.
- **No Wi-fi:** Please let your DJ know we do not have Wi-fi and they should come prepared to hook to a hotspot
- **Seating Chart:** Alphabetical listing is the quickest way for guests to find themselves.
- **Leftover Food:** Please bring appropriate coolers needed to store your leftover food overnight if you are staying at a hotel as we are not back in the office until Monday.
