8:45pm Guests transition outside

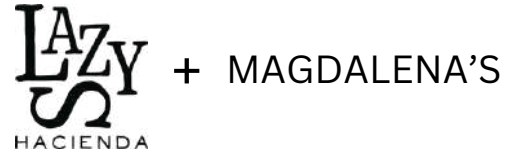
