Outdoor Ceremony

Centennial Hall

Historic Lodge

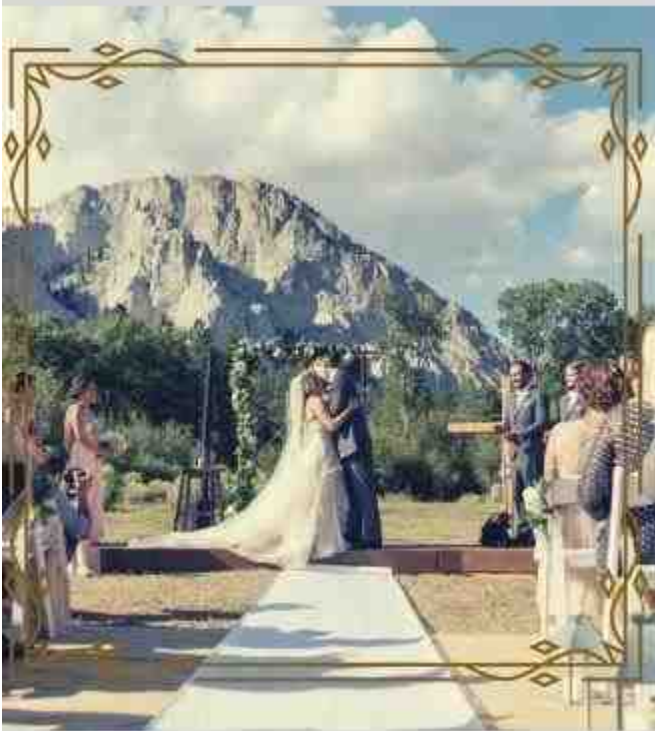
**Dining Rooms 1 & 2, deck, with common space*
