

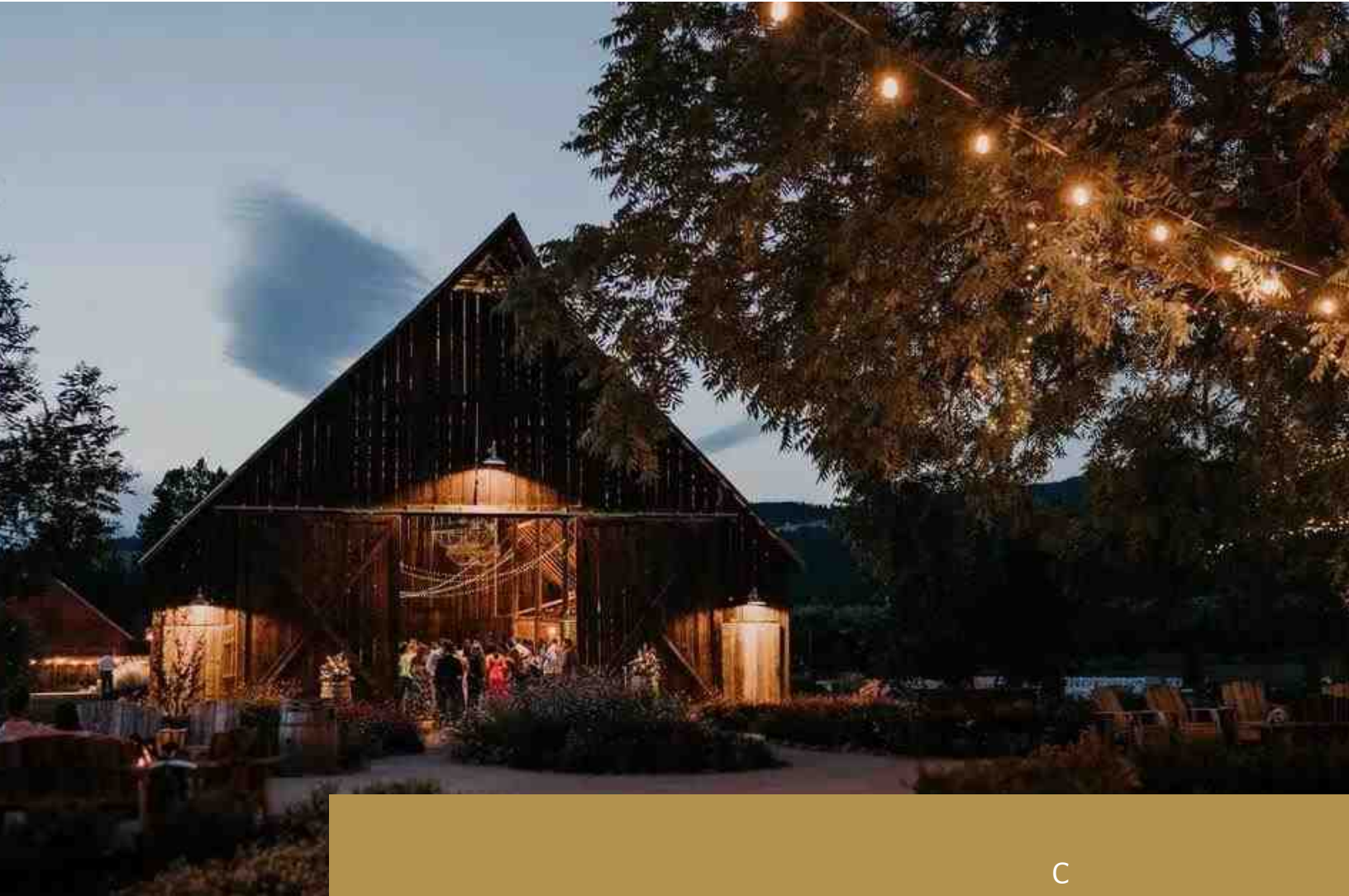

Private Dressing Quarters

Two separate locations allow for each side of the wedding party to dress and prepare for the big event. Each offers a private entrance, bathroom, kitchen or bar area, sitting area, and dressing area.



Ceremony Patio

The ceremony patio overlooks the mountains, orchards, and forest with a wisteria covered arbor. The aisle is flanked by two wine barrels and Adirondack seating areas.



The Barn

3,400 sq feet of dining and entertainment space, including a catering room, furnished lounge areas, indoor/outdoor dance floor, built-in DJ booth, in-house sound system, custom chandeliers, dessert table, and wine & beer bar



The Pavilion

The pavilion is an alternate ceremony space if a covered option is needed. It features a massive outdoor fireplace, outdoor bar, and a large seating area. For the majority of celebrations where an alternate ceremony location is not needed, the pavilion is used for guests to gather during cocktail hour, following their ceremony.



The Meadow & Courtyard

The barn's courtyard and meadow offer a tranquil area for guests to relax with a propane fire pit, outdoor seating, lawn games, a drink table, and lush landscaping.

Wedding Package



What's Included:

- 12 hours onsite (11 hours for your wedding including setup and breakdown, plus a 1-hour rehearsal the day prior).
- Use of the Barn, The Courtyard, Ceremony Patio, Pavilion, the Windmill Meadow, Private Dressing Quarters, restroom facility & lighted parking.
- Custom farm tables with turned legs for the reception.
- Mismatch wood dining chairs for the reception.
- A variety of indoor and outdoor furnishings.
- 180 upgraded white resin ceremony chairs.

Pricing:

- Saturdays: \$10,800
- Fridays and Sundays: \$8,600
- Wednesdays and Thursdays: \$6,400



FAQs



What is the weather like?

White Salmon, situated east of the Cascade range, blends desert and rain. Springs bring occasional showers, summers are dry and warm, and falls offer colorful abundance and pleasant temperatures.

Are pets allowed?

Yes! Couples may bring their furry companions for the ceremony and cocktail hour. However, pets must be removed for their safety once the reception starts.

Is there a backup weather plan?

We built the timber-framed pavilion in 2016 to be the alternate ceremony location, should there be rain in the forecast, or if it is just too hot to be in the direct sun.

Do you have a designated parking area?

Yes, we do. We can accommodate up to 90 vehicles in our lighted field parking area. We do strongly recommend group transportation to keep potentially tipsy drivers from getting behind the wheel.

Do you have more than one wedding a day?

Absolutely not! We focus on you and want you to have the most amazing day of your life so there is only one event allowed per day.

What are your alcohol policies?

We allow beer, wine, cider, and champagne at Tin Roof Barn. We also allow hard alcohol in the form of mixed "Signature Drinks" during cocktail hour. Your caterer will provide bartenders for alcohol service.

Are there decor restrictions?

Our two big decor restrictions would be that flames are not allowed - but flameless candles are welcome - and we do not allow flowers to be thrown during the ceremony or grand exit.

Are there sound restrictions?

Yes. Due to rural sound restrictions, live bands aren't permitted during the reception at our barn venue. However, your DJ can use our in-house speaker system for reception and dance music. Live music is allowed for the ceremony and cocktail hour.

Is the venue handicap accessible?


We want to make sure all your guests can experience the magic of Tin Roof Barn; the entire venue is certified accessible with the exception of the Dressing Quarters.
